Mrs. Georgia Neville Sloan Succumbs In East Franklin

The widow of Jesse Siler Sloan, Mrs. Georgia Neville Sloan, one of a few nonagenarians in Macon County, succumbed Wednesday of last week (October 29) at 4 p.m. at her home in East Franklin. She was 92.

Born in Oconee County, S. C., she had lived here for the past 70 years and was a life member of the Women's Society of Christian Service of the Franklin Methodist Church. Also, she was a charter member of Nequassa

Chapter No. 43, Order of the Eastern Star.
