The information above is from the Leona Bryson Porter book The Family of Weimar Siler 1755-1831.

The family book states that Weimar was born in Pennsylvania and that Margaret was born in Virginia. No source is given for this information.

The family book states that Weimar and Margaret's eldest child, Esther, was born in Virginia, on the Holston River. No source is given for this information.

According to the family book, Thomas Siler was killed in the Chickasaw Purchase in TN. The government negotiated the purchase of land in Tennessee from the Chickasaw in 1818. One of the negotiators was Andrew Jackson and the transaction is also referred to as the *Jackson Purchase*.
